#### INTERVIEW EXAM EVALUATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. In the calculation of the success evaluation grade, 80% of the undergraduate graduation grade point average and 20% of the interview exam are taken into consideration in master's degree applications. For students who score below 50 points out of 100 in the interview exam, the success evaluation grade is not determined, and these students are considered unsuccessful and are not included in the ranking. In addition, in order for a student to be considered successful, the total score to be obtained from the undergraduate graduation average and interview exam grades must be at least 50 points. For Ph.D. applications, 80% of the master's degree grade point average and 20% of the interview are taken into consideration. For students who score below 50 points out of 100 in the interview exam, the success evaluation grade is not determined, and these students are considered unsuccessful and are not included in the ranking. In addition, in order for a student to be considered successful, the total score to be obtained from the master's graduation average and interview exam grades must be at least 60.
